- A. But they did not recognize him.
- B. They ate with him.
- C. He revealed himself to them in the meal (in "the breaking of the bread").
- D. They saw and believed and understood.
- E. They shared what they had encountered/experienced.

II. FROM THE DAY YOU WERE BAPTIZED JESUS HAS BEEN WALKING WITH YOU IN YOUR LIFE; HE HAS BEEN A PART OF YOUR STORY.

- A. But until the last couple of years you didn't know that -- you did not recognize him because you were too young.
- B. But today he is going to share a meal with you; he is going to share his Body and Blood with you.
- C. And in yet another way Jesus will come and stay with you -- will you recognize him in this celebration and in this meal he shares with you?
- D. Will you now let him continue to teach you and to nourish you as you grow?

E. And in return Jesus wants you to share him with others -- when people see you may they see a little bit of Jesus.

III. JESUS WALKS WITH US. JESUS CAMINA CON NOSOTROS.

- A. But we often don't recognize him -- apathy, neglect, sin. **Pero muchas veces no reconocemos a el - por causa del pecado**
- B. But week after week he shares this meal of his Body and Blood with us. **Cada semana el comparte una comida con nosotros - su Cuerpo y su Sangre**
- C. Do we recognize him here? Or do we take this meal for granted? Do we let him vanish from our sight, or do we take him with us. **¿Nosotros reconocemos a el aquí?**
- D. Let's remember that we become what we receive here; he calls us to be his risen presence to one another and to all whom we will meet. **Recordemos que hacemos lo que recibimos aquí ahora; y el nos llama ser su presencia para todos lo que encontramos en nuestra vida diaria**
